Have mercy on us, bring us back to yourself as those who once lived in darkness,

but now have life in the light of Christ our Lord. Amen.

Heavenly Father, forgive us by the death of the Son, and strengthen us to live in the power of The Spirit all our days. **Amen.** he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is worshipped and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church.

We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.

We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.
